Topic: Teacher protections

Summary: HB 1952 creates new law. The language states that the district cannot prohibit or discipline a teacher for disclosing public information to correct what the teacher reasonably believes evidences a violation of the Oklahoma Constitution, a law, or a rule, or for reporting a violation of the Oklahoma Constitution or state or federal law. Teachers are not required to give prior notice of any disclosure they intend to make.

The district is required to post or publish notice of this new law in locations (plural) where teachers are likely to see it.

No changes are anticipated for any district policy.
