Topic: OHLAP

Summary: SB 0529 amends several provisions of the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program.

Beginning with applicants in the 2017 - 2018 school year, the student's family's adjusted gross income must be below \$55,000 at the time of application. Beginning with applicants in the 2021 - 2022 school year, the student's family's adjusted gross income must be below \$60,000 at the time of application.

Beginning with the 2018 - 2019 school year, the student's family's adjusted gross income must not exceed \$100,000 at the time of the student's post-secondary attendance.

Beginning with the 2018 - 2019 school year, OHLAP awards cannot be used for remediation or no credit courses.

No changes are anticipated for any district policy or procedure, but high school counselors should be aware of these changes so they can advise students appropriately.
