## **Red Banner Update**

Effective: 90 days Sine Die Adjournment (currently scheduled for May 31, 2024)

**Topic:** Teacher Dismissal

**Summary:** This bill amends existing law (70 O.S. § 6-101.25) regarding superintendent recommendations for dismissal or nonreemployment of a teacher. The bill revises current law which requires a district to provide certain recommendations to the State Board of Education. Now, any recommendation which includes a reason set forth in subparagraph a of paragraph 6 of subsection A of Section 3-104 (Section 3-104 pertains to any person convicted or who has received a suspended sentence or any probationary term for a crime or an attempt to commit a crime involving sexual abuse or sexual exploitation), and is based on an agreement between the teacher and school district to avoid civil litigation or a settlement of a civil action must be provided to the State Board of Education as well, unless the court orders the terms of such settlement to be kept confidential.
